

A Simple Technique to Overcome ICSI Fertilization Failure

Aggressive sperm immobilization significantly improved fertilization rates in patients with a history of ICSI fertilization failure, without negatively impacting embryo quality. This technique also resulted in more embryos available for transfer and a higher live birth rate compared to the standard method. Therefore, aggressive immobilization may serve as a safe, effective, and cost-efficient strategy to enhance reproductive outcomes in challenging ICSI cases.
